2.	On Page 4 of the RFP, the County states that "The selected firm will provide all materials, equipment, and labor to complete this project." Could you clarify what types of equipment the County anticipates requiring the chosen program management firm to provide? Although the Standard Terms and Conditions state in Section 29 that bonds are required only occasionally for non- construction contracts, could you confirm whether the County anticipates requiring bonds from the chosen program management firm? On page 11 of the RFP, the solicitation references " Compliance with Regulations - Contractor shall comply with the Regulations relative to nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the U.S.D.O.T., Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 21" and "facilities as may be determined by the County or the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) or the Federal Highway Administration." Does the County anticipate including Transportation projects in the scope of work for this Program Manager solicitation?	Page 11	Boiler plate language included in all County solicitations. Given the mention of Procore later in the solicitation, could you confirm whether using Procore will be the County's preference for this program? If so, could you clarify whether Procore Licenses will be supplied by the County and whether Procore's intended use will be for management of all program expenses and reporting or monitoring only by the program management firm?	Page 15	Procore has been provided by the county for each project. Procore's intended use will be for management of the program budget, commitments, and invoicing.
