Clarification in regards to Chattahoochee Pointe Park:

1. Attached is a map in regards to the Chattahoochee Pointe Park's Disc Golf Course that is under design/construction. The map shows the 18 disc golf holes and fairways, which will need to be cut every other week or at least twice per month during the growing season of April through September). Height should be 3-4". The area to be maintained is approximately 13 +/- acres. Each fairway will be field marked with colored spray paint to visually define the area for the successful contractor by the time services are to begin. Outside the shaded fairway areas are required to be bush hogged monthly.

Response to questions received (*response in italics*)

2. **Should pricing for adding the mulch to beds at Old Atlanta Park be included in the pricing for that location?** *As stated monument signs are to be mulched two (2) times per year with colored wood mulch. If additional mulch is required at this site it would be on an as needed basis.*
