Questions/Revisions

- 1) On page#5 of the bid document it is stated that "Any supplier/vendor/contractor providing services to Forsyth County shall have a Forsyth County business license". As we are New Jersey based company and we don't have Forsyth County business license so can we bid in that case?

Answer: Yes, any supplier may bid on this solicitation. Any supplier providing services to Forsyth County is to have a Forsyth County business license only to the extent required by law, to include the County's business license/occupation tax ordinance.

- 2) There's a waiver for notary by including a copy of the driver's license. Can I provide a copy of a passport?

Answer: Due to Covid 19, Forsyth County will accept a valid government issued id.
