

Mental Health Outpatient Crisis Center & Health Department





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[COMBINED FACILITY]

By combining the Mental Health Outpatient & Crisis Center with the Health Department many operational and construction efficiencies will occur. Shared utility, back of house and site construction elements will result in a substantial cost savings for the facility. Since many times, patients require both sets of services, the marriage of these two important functions will create a superior delivery of health and mental health services for the citizens.

The total proposed facility is 62,000 SF.

The combined **construction savings** will be between \$750,000 to \$1,000,000 versus building two separate facilities.



The Mental Health Outpatient & Crisis Center is an important facility to address the community effects of COVID. Throughout the county, the impact of COVID on the citizens was revealed in the increased demand for mental health services. The Mental Health Outpatient & Crisis Center will be designed to mitigate the most severely impacted citizens as well as the outpatient needs of the citizens due to the COVID crisis. Some Data of the facility has been included in the next column.

- » The mental portion of the proposed facility is 40,000 SF.
- » The inpatient facility will include secure and walk in admission areas for inpatient services
- » For inpatient services, it will have a 15 bed 24 hour observation unit and a 30 bed treatment wing. The facility will also include the support and administrative spaces needed for these important services.
- » For outpatient services, the building will have multiple group rooms and counseling offices to address the continuity of care that was affected by COVID.
- » The facility will be designed with future expansion capabilities.

The existing Health Department
Facility was severely unprepared
for the COVID Crisis. Shortages of
vaccine cold storage, PPE storage/
distribution areas and administration
of vaccine treatment areas revealed
the inadequacies of the facility.
The new facility will be designed
to mitigate any future pandemic
interruption of services and to improve
the health department efficiencies
outcomes.

- » The health department portion of the proposed facility is 17,000 SF.
- » The facility will be designed to quickly and effectively respond to a future pandemic.
- » The facility will include increased patient treatment areas, lab areas and a central nurses station to deliver these important services.
- » The facility will be designed with future expansion capabilities.
